Classes

Baby-class: from 3 months old - end of 5th month. Puppy-class: from 6 months - end of 8th month. Youth class: from 9months - end of 17th month.

Intermediate class: from 15 months - end of 23th month (free choice)

Open class: from 18 months until Veteran class

Champion class: for International and Austrian Champions

Veteran class: all setters from the end of the 8h year

Breeder group: A breeder group consists of at least 3 members of one breed and one breeder, who are already entered in one of the other classes.

You will receive confirmation in good time before the event. Every competitor will receive a catalogue and a start number at the entry control.


In accordance with animal protection and event rules, every competitor must carry an immunization pass with a valid rabies immunity stamp (at least 30 days old and not older than one year) for the duration of the competition and must produce it on demand (§14). All dogs must either wear a muzzle or be taken on the lead so that their behavior is controlled at all times(§15). During the competion, there is a complete ban on smoking in all competition rooms (§1-1). The immunization pass, with pedigree and relevant proof of championship status, is to be shown along with proof of payment. The competitor is liable for any damages caused by their dog. Dogs that bite must wear a muzzle.
